A reasonable entry of store cattle for the time of year, with a stronger trade than the last sale overall with the steers averaging £911/head up to £1295/head for a 625kg steer from M/s T V Jones & Co, who also had others at £1250 and £1200/head. A varying show of cattle but men forward for all types. Again the younger sorts were the dearest sold with a bunch of 300kg Limousins from M/s R & H M Fairclough making £740/head up to 247p/kg.

The heifers were also a sharper trade averaging just short of 200p/kg up to 256p/kg for a 320kg Limousin heifer from Mr E T Jenkins. The heifers averaged £842/head up to £1085/head for a Limousin from M/s D A & S E Jones. Overall much sharper and more could have been sold.

BARREN COWS - 5

A very short entry with more men to bid for cows than cows forward. Hereford cross to £1030 (173p/kg). Other smaller, plainer cows from £660 to £850 (116p-137p/kg). A single over-age steer to £945 (185p/kg). Many more cows needed each sale with tremendous support for this section.

BEEF TYPE COWS & CALVES/IN-CALF - 37 & calves

The feature of the sale was the dispersal of the traditional Hereford herd on behalf of Lower Turnant Farm Partnership. The cattle looked exceptionally well and were sold to a crowd of purchasers from far and wide - some cattle were sold to Brisbane, Australia. The strongest outfits from £800 to £1000 topping at £1120. Smaller and older outfits trading from £650 to £800. In-calf cows to £1000, the bulling heifers created good interest from £750 to £920. The yearling heifers proved harder to cash and trading from £400 to £550. Commercial cows and calves met good interest despite the continued shortage of grass. An excellent run of strong Blue & Blonde x cows with strong Angus calves at foot topped at £1580. Other strong outfits from £1400 to £1500. Smaller outfits and younger calves from £1100 to £1300, however it was pleasing to see farmers with confidence to continue to buy cows and calves.
