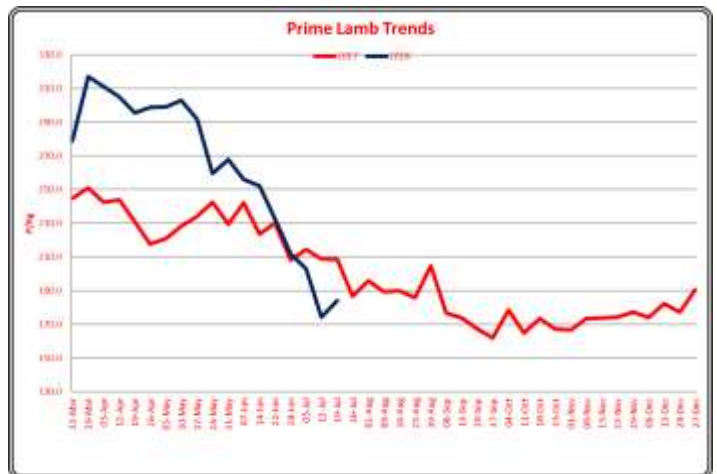

A welcomed increased entry met an excellent trade with a larger crowd of purchasers present. The small drop of rain has helped in some places with buyers certainly keener for lambs. Ignore the overall average as this includes 250 hill bred very small sorts. Strongest lambs to £75 for Texel ram lambs, other stronger sorts from £66 to £73.20, strong ram lambs and well meated types needed in the next few weeks. Farming lambs from £60 to £65.50 with plenty of larger bunches trading from £63 to £67.

Smaller well bred sorts from £55 to £59.50 with very small long keeping lambs trading £40 to £50. Several Mule type ram lambs - these needing condition to obtain the best returns, strongest sorts £54 to £60, smaller types £42 to £50. As mentioned a large run of very small hill type lambs - these trading generally from £32 to £46 with very, very small from £10 to £24.50. A complete clearance with more needed in the coming weeks to satisfy current demand.

Another nice show of breeders, with the Suffolk breed to the fore. Best 2 year old ewes to £155 and again at £154, £149 and £144 twice; other 2 year olds from £119 to £130. Suffolk yearlings to £138, some very smart pens of 3 year olds to £119, £118 etc. Older ewes from £96 to £110. Texel cross yearling ewes to £120.

CULL EWES - 2613

A strong entry of cull ewes with surprisingly a lot still in the wool! There is more demand for those shorn ewes. The strongest ewes are still in the best demand and easier sold than last week with ewes topping at £135/head and others at £134 and £128/head. Suffolks to £108.50/head. A very large majority of those hill bred Welsh and Speckle ewes forward. The plainest types would be the hardest to sell. Meat and frame no problem. Any amount of men forward for ewes today, hard to believe but 12 buyers forward for ewes which ensured a truly competitive trade, where else can you find 12 buyers for your cull stock?
