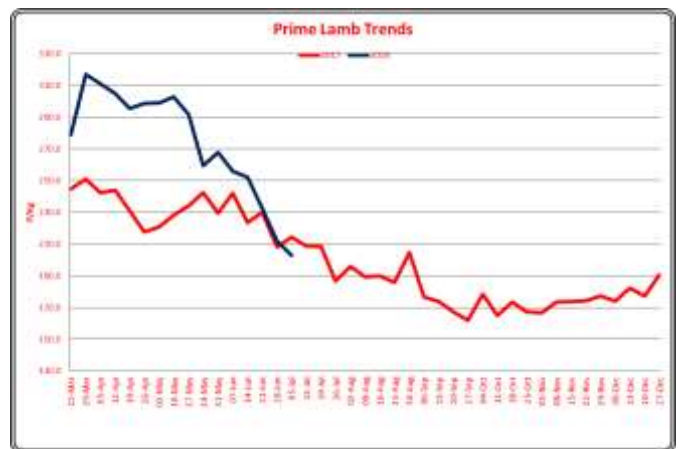

Another superb entry of ewes with those strongest meated sorts still a very good trade especially those good continentals which was illustrated in a pen of 14 Texel ewes that soared to £146/head. Top 20 prices recorded all in excess of £108/head. Those strong Suffolks were £90 to £110. The hardest selling ewes at the moment are those lean hill types especially if they are in the wool.

A majority of smaller ewes forward and it would be of benefit to get them shorn! There are several grazing/feeding men looking for ewes but they ideally need to be shorn to attract these buyers. Rams also a good trade soaring to £190/head for a stockgetter, others at £116, £110 etc. Nine cull ewe buyers in attendance representing many more firms ensuring a buoyant trade!
