A terrific entry of stores especially for the time of year. An entry that were mainly made up of second and third draws but nevertheless a good entry of proper store cattle. The strength was in well sought after cattle topping at £1220/head for a pair of Charolais steers from E J Williams, The Bryn. The top 20 stores all over £1000/head and an overall average of £810/head was achieved to include all types. Again the smaller and younger they were, the dearer they were with a 350kg Limousin steer from M/s E L Morgan & Sons, Neuadd topping at 257p/kg (£900/head). Top 20 steers all over 216p/kg.

The heifers were a very similar trade, in fact averaging high on the same at £800/head. Heifers topped at £1090/head for a 570kg Blonde from M/s W H Lewis & Co, Cotmore Farm. Top 20 prices all over £980/head. A shortage of real strength forward. Heifers topped at 268p/kg and top 20 prices all over 210p/kg. All in all a good trade with any amount of buyers forward, in fact several fresh faces forward. More cattle required every sale.

What an absolute flyer of a trade, serious demand from start to finish. Plenty of buyers wanting feeding bulls, you literally needed to be there to see it. A pair of 250kg bulls from M/s M & S Bricknell topped at 290p/kg but there were plenty close behind at 275p/kg, 271p, 273p etc. A lovely run of bulls from M/s W T & J M Probert, Lower Hunt House saw plenty of interest selling between £1000 and £1050/head. Another run from M/s F J & R C Probert, Rylstone also sold extremely well with a 360kg Limousin making £990/head. As part of the dispersal from M/s Simcock a pedigree stock bull sold to £1850/head. All in all a terrific trade and more bulls are required every sale.
