STORE CATTLE - 300

A very nice entry of store cattle for January, a real proper show with a large majority of Charolais forward, attracting a terrific crowd of buyers.

All these good stretchy sorts a lovely trade with the steers soaring to £1260/head for a 595kg Salers cross steer from J R Lloyd & Son, Cefn y Blaen who had a superb run of cattle forward. The top 20 stores were all over £1070/head with plenty over £1100. Steers from Mr D H Bentley and P & D Evans selling at £1210 and £1190 respectively. The heifers were also a good trade with a 510kg Charolais from J H Taylor, Upper Newton soaring to £1125/head. Plenty of heifers in excess of 200p/kg with a 470kg topping at 221p/kg (£1050/head) from J H Lloyd & Son, Cefn y Blaen. **It's simply horses for courses, there were buyers for everything and all types, it's simply the better end and stretchy types are easiest sold.** The steers averaged £960/head (201p/kg) and heifers £751/head (151p/kg).

There is some sort of trade on these feeding bulls at the moment and plenty more could have been sold on the trade. Those nice young continental bulls 290kg to 380kg are in terrific demand topping at 265p/kg for a 370kg Limousin from M V & J M Davies, Wernwyn; others at 257p/kg, 247p/kg etc. A definite shortage with any amount of buyers forward that were left short. A nice young Pedigree Limousin breeding bull from the same stable saw good interest selling to £1500/head. There are now farmers looking for breeding bulls so if you have any let us know so they can be appropriately advertised. More feeding bulls desperately required.

BARREN COWS - 24

Cows a much sharper trade averaging 115p/kg and to include all types, an average of £600/head was attained topping at £1000/head for a 725kg Blue cow from Messrs C E & A M Millichap. Other cows closely followed at £940, £935, £895 and £885 etc. The best framed, meated and farm assured cows are in greatest demand with cows flying to 143p/kg and others close behind at 142p/kg, 138p/kg, 132p/kg and with seven buyers in attendance many many more cows could have been sold.
