133 pigs offered with all pigs selling and five new buyers attending. A **selective trade throughout with harder trade across country on butchers' weights**. Two black gilts topped at £128, white bacon cutters made from £76-£120. Quality white porkers £50-£76 with coloured stores topping at £74. Poorer coloured stores hard to sell, but stores topped at £31. As ever cut male pigs in far more demand than entire boars.
