A much larger entry of pigs with a selective trade, again with 'ready to kill' pigs having best price, especially white pigs. A run of 10 sows topped at £100, best white cutters ranged from £84 to £96. A huge range of price in the porkers and stores dependant upon quality with again well shaped cut or gilts in best demand. In all sections uncut boar pigs are harder to sell. Best quality strong white weaners ranged from £25 to £30. Each week Hereford Market continues to see both vendors and purchasers from greater distances.
