## HEIFERS & STEERS - 537

Another huge entry of store cattle which included an excellent show of cattle for mid-May. Several runs of strong cattle with these easy to place throughout, topping at £1295 from M/s F D Grosvenor & Co with no end of strong stores from £1100 to £1290. Several bunches £1200 plus. Farming steers were shorter in numbers, however were a fast trade with the better bred sorts from £1000 to £1170 (220p-240p/kg). The well bred younger steers from £880 to £1020 with plenty at £920 to £1000 (225p-269p/kg). Smaller, younger steers from £700 to £800 with some fitter, younger sorts slightly less money than recent weeks. Several native bred steers with Angus to £1070, other farming sorts from £800 to £950 (185p-210p/kg). Plainer steers looking well sold (160p-175p/kg) and generally £600 to £700. Steers averaged 198p/kg (£905/head).

A large number of heifers forward with nearly twice as many heifers as steers, topping at £1155 for a super heifer from M/s J T Jones & Sons. Other stronger heifers from £1020 to £1130. Some very good runs of smart heifers look very well sold (210p-230p/kg). Farming heifers from £900 to £1000 with some smart butcher types very keenly sought after from 220p-235p/kg. Plainer types from £850 to £920 (175p-195p/kg). Younger heifers saw plenty of fitter types - these were slightly harder work which is normal for mid-May. Well bred younger sorts from £800 to £950 (220p-235p/kg). Fleshed heifers from £700 to £800 (170p-185p/kg). Younger sorts from £600 to £700. Native bred sorts from £650 to £800 depending on quality (165p-185p/kg). Overall heifers averaged 187p/kg (£815/head). Another large ring full of purchasers with some new faces again appearing in Hereford. Cattle going to all parts of the country, with the show of cattle a credit to the vendors. Many purchasers commented on the quality here in Hereford.

# **BARREN COWS - 31**

An excellent entry of barren cows sold to another strong trade to average 135p/kg soaring to 186p/kg for a 590kg Limousin from M/s Powell Partners, Upper Newton that made £1095/head. The cows averaged a pleasing £833/head up to £1195/head for a 700kg Blonde from M/s Harper and Sons, Pinford Farm. The top 20 cows and calves were all over £880/head.

Well fleshed farm assured cows were in serious demand with any amount of cows 140p/kg plus. Seven cow buyers in attendance.

### FEEDING & STOCK/BREEDING BULLS - 93

A lovely entry of bulls - some very nice breeding bulls to include a very nice pedigree Limousin bull, 25 months old from M/s Samuel, Orlham Farm making a very respectable £2600/head and a younger bull from M/s Barrett, Mintridge, Stoke Lacy soaring to £2300. Again horses for courses - plenty of demand for the right things.

The feeding bulls also very well sought after and averaged 210p/kg right through soaring to 244p/kg for a 385kg Limousin that made £940/head. Best bulls to £1220/head for a run of Simmental bulls from M/s Greenow who had others at £1160, £1100, £1090. Any amount of bulls 220p/kg plus. Plenty of competition throughout and more could have easily been sold.

# BEEF TYPE COWS/HEIFERS IN OR WITH CALVES AND BULLING HEIFERS - 57

A superb entry of cows and calves both in terms of numbers and quality. A full crowd of buyers around the ring wanting nice farming outfits. Some terrific runs of cattle forward to include the genuine dispersal sale of Morgan-Jones & Son, Sugwas.

A small dispersal of heifers and calves from M/s L J & G V Rea, Middlewick Farm were the highlight of the day soaring to £2450 for two separate outfits, with an overall average of £2225/head achieved. It just shows there is plenty of demand for the right outfits. The Morgan-Jones dispersal also received lovely interest topping at £1800/head with plenty selling between £1400 and £1700 especially the younger sorts. To include the whole herd dispersal even the older cows averaged a very pleasing £1360.

The in-calvers were also very well sought after topping at £1580 with others at £1480, £1400, £1320 etc. A nice bunch of heifers from M/s Davies, Maesclettwr also saw great interest and sold between £1600 and £1880. A great trade throughout.
