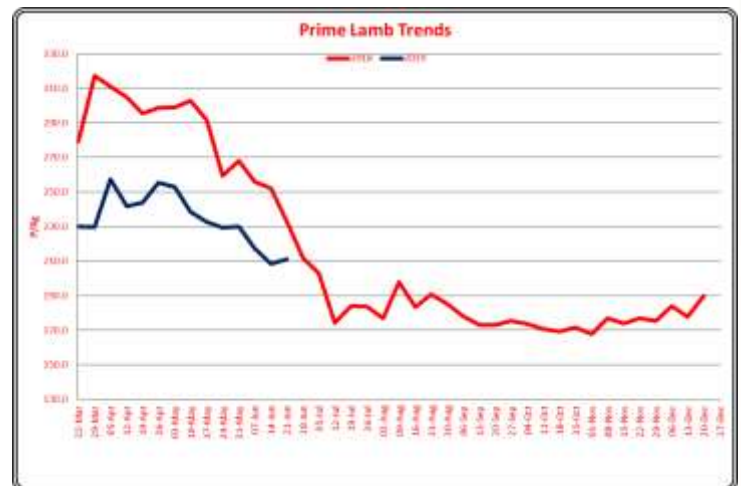

REARING/WEANED CALVES - 33

An entry comprising mostly rearing calves under 42 days included some stronger sorts than recent weeks. Top price calf was £385 for a strong Angus cross bull out of a British Friesian cow from I J & M E Bailey who sold older heifer calves at £370, £340 and £330. Other good beef cross calves to £300 for a British Blue bull and from £170 to £240. Hereford cross bulls to £285. Several heifer calves on offer selling to £280 for a Charollais cross, British Blue cross from £100 to £260, Hereford cross heifers from £90 to £250. Just 4 weaned calves included a Salers cross bull, 9 months at £480 and Limousin cross bull at £370. Hereford cross bull, 3 months at £380, a Hereford cross heifer same age at £300.

Still some nice quality couples about with plenty of purchasers needing sheep to make use of the abundant grass. Last few from Rob Bevan, Penydre but still very respectable, selling to £210 for a 2 year old ewe with twins. Others from the same home at £200 and £175. Texel yearlings with lambs to £144, and again at £125. Mule 2 year old ewes with one lamb to £136, with full and broken mouth to £118. Suffolk 2 year old ewes to £128. Harder bred ewes with smart lambs easily sold between £80 and £84.

Hoggs and lambs found plenty of customers with Suffolks to £140 (twice) and again at £131. A selection of smaller hoggs with lambs of various breeds from £80 to £120.

STORE LAMBS - 340

A larger entry of store lambs sold to a better trade than last week, with any amount of men to bid for the sheep. Top price of £69 for a pen of 40 with the same holding selling at £66 and £65. Other pens of lambs at £66.50, £64, £63 with an excellent overall average of £64.17.

A few nice pens of ewe hoggs on offer, with a very smart pen of Suffolks to £97. Texel hoggs to £96, and again at £95 and £81. Mixed hoggs to £62.

CULL EWES - 2671

A good entry of ewes, with some types £20/head dearer than last week. The best types to £134/head, with others at £129, £126, £123 and £120/head. Plenty of demand from start to finish, with eight buyers forward ensuring this buoyant trade. Again the leanest ewes would easily outsell the fat. Plenty of little Welsh and Speckle ewes £60 to £70/head.

The market average would not reflect the trade forward, as there was a significant majority of smaller plainer ewes forward with runs and runs of Welsh Speckle types.
