## **REARING/WEANED CALVES - 19**

The smaller entry which included just 4 calves under 42 days, highlighted by 2 Limousin cross bulls out of British Friesian cows, they sold to £340 and £310 showing demand for fresh sorts. 2 Hereford cross bulls again sold to demand at £190 and £70. Weaned sorts to £405 for a small but good shaped Hereford cross heifer at 9 months. Other heifers from £270 to £350. Several customers looking but quality was generally lacking.

Keep the quantity coming. Early entries for next week include 4 British Blue cross heifers 6/7 months, 4 Angus cross bulls 6/7 months, 2 freemartin Friesian heifers 8 months.

A very seasonal entry of 96 ewes and hoggs with lambs at foot. Still several purchasers with a bunch of hoggs and lambs to £148, other hoggs and lambs to £130 and £108. Ewes and lambs were nearly all hill bred sorts - these £72 to £86 for mainly full and broken mouth Welsh and Hardy Speckles, other ewes and lambs from £108 to £125.

## **STORE LAMBS - 380**

A nice entry of store lambs met a very competitive trade with a large crowd of purchasers and prospective purchasers. More lambs could have easily been sold with farmers with grass keen for sheep. A good run from Hyde Brothers topped at £69.50 for Suffolk x Mules with Texels from the same home to £68.50. Smart Texels to £67.20 with other smarter sorts £60 to £64, well bred farming lambs generally all £60 plus, smaller well bred sorts £54 to £59.50, a few very small sorts £30 to £45.

## **CULL EWES - 3265**

A strong entry of ewes sold to a slightly easier trade if anything but then better Texel ewes sold to £128/head. Again the leaner types are much dearer than the fat with plenty of good selling Suffolk ewes £87 to £95/head. Top 20 prices all over £103/head and an overall average of £67/head was attained which would include a significant majority of smaller Welsh and Speckle ewes. These types still in excellent demand with pen after pen £60 to £70/head and again the leaner the better. Tups slightly firmer selling to £111/head with a few buyers looking for the odd one to run round again. It would take a very good Mule to break £80. 11 buyers in actual attendance which ensures maximum competition for all stock forward.
