STORE CATTLE

A short entry for our first sale in July with a good crowd of purchasers present and cattle going to all parts of the country. Despite the fat trade still being very much in the doldrums the stores looked well sold and dearer than two weeks ago.

Steers to £1235 (610kg) from Mr S Higginson, other stronger steers from £1100 to £1200 with a good run of Charolais x steers from M/s M Lewis & Son, Llanbedr Hall. Farming steers from £950 to £1050, a smart steer to £1020 (450kg). Younger stores dearer and trading from £750 to £900 (200p-277p/kg). Native steers to £905 for Angus and £900 for Herefords.

More heifers than steers with some nice runs of heifers, best to £1130. Other strong sorts £950 to £1060 (185p-202p/kg). Farming heifers from £850 to £950, smart Charolais x heifers to £940 (480kg) from M/s J L & K H Nixon & Sons. A nice run of pure Simmental heifers from £760 to £810 from Mr C M Mercer. Smaller sorts and plainer types harder work from £520 to £700 depending on size.

A nice entry of cull cows sold to a lovely trade, slightly firmer than last sale averaging 130p/kg up to 170p/kg for a pair of Charolais x weighing 530kg from M/s M Lewis & Son, Llanbedr Hall. A top price of £980/head achieved for a Limousin cow from Mr J Barber, Tymynydd. An overall average of £821/head was achieved. Plenty of demand and a definite shortage of those best farm assured cows.

FEEDING & BREEDING BULLS - 16

A grand trade on the feeding bulls to average 192p/kg up to 208p/kg for a pair of Blue bulls from Mr D J Bushell, The Stables. A top price of £948/head was achieved. A good show of quality but disappointing in terms of numbers. More could have been sold on this trade.
