Following last weeks successful start to the breeding ewe season, we are pleased to report a terrific sale!

Two annual drafts of 2yr old Suffolk ewes, the first from Nigel and Rob Bowen, sold to the joint top price of £146, with others at £145, (4 lots), and £140. 2yr old Suffolk cross half bred ewes from the same home to £145, with Mule 2yr olds to £140.

George and Matthew Sevenoaks also sold to £146, (2 lots), with others at £138, (2 lots). Other smart Suffolk 2yr olds to £145, (2 lots). Mule 2yr olds to £140.

Excellent demand for older ewes, with 3 and 4yr old Suffolks to £125, several lots then between £110 and £120. Texel x similar age ewes to £123 and generally £100 to £115. A few bunches of smaller older ewes between £75 to £100 for various breeds,

A larger entry with nearly 1000 lambs on offer, with trade exceptionally strong, although a little loess than last week. A good crowd of purchasers all keen for lamb, saw the strength easy to place.

Ram lambs to £74 for Charolais cross, a good run of Suffolk x ram lambs topped at £72. Other stronger sorts from £64 to £72, smaller farming sorts from £54 to £60.

Clean lambs to £71.50, other stronger well bred lambs £63 to £69 throughout the sale. Medium lambs from £56 to £62, with a nice show of well bred farming lambs. Smaller longer term lambs look well sold between £44 to £54, depending on breed and potential. Very small plain sorts from £35 to £42.
