

The larger entry attracted more buyers with a firm trade throughout. All calves were under 42 days and sold to £385 for a strong Simmental x bull, part of a draft of 14 calves from M/s D A & W G Jones who sold 8 other bulls from £285 to £355 and with his best heifers - Limousin x from £305 to £335. The draft of strong Angus x calves sold to £340 for a bull, with heifers to £260. Several British Blue x calves on offer with bulls from £160 to £260. Heifers from £140 to £225. Consignment of nicely reared younger Limousin crosses ranged from £160 to £210. A total clearance effected. Overall average £230.56.

## **BREEDING EWES - 927**

Another good quality entry of breeding ewes with more yearlings on offer sold to a large crowd. Customers for all breeds and sizes. Top price of £140 on two occasions - both Texel x yearlings. Other better pens from £120 to £138. Suffolk x yearlings sold to £138. Several pens from £120 to £136. Mule yearlings sold to better interest with prices from £106 to £114.

Older ewes always attracted good interest and sold to £135 for Suffolk x 2 year olds. Other better pens from £114 to £128. Suffolk x 3 year olds sold to £130 for stronger sorts with other nice pens from £100 to £118. The draft of North Country Mule 2 and 3 year olds, recently weaned all sold at £100. Throughout the sale smaller, harder bred ewes sold from £62 to £98 with virtually a total clearance.

An exceptional entry for mid August with over twice as many lambs forward as the corresponding week last year. Another very good show of lambs forward with several excellent runs. The dearest lambs again the strongest and the smallest with the farming lambs slightly less money than last week.

Strongest stores to £78 for a bunch of 30 Charollais x ram lambs with several bunches trading £67 to £74.80. A super run of shapely Texels to £71.50 with a bunch of 50 Suffolk x Mule wethers to £73.50. Short-keep lambs easy to place throughout. Farming lambs a little easier from £60 to £66 although the continental lambs better sold than Suffolk x lambs this week.

All nicely bred lambs £63 to £66, with stronger plainer sorts £60 to £63. Medium keeping lambs from £54 to £59.50 with the well bred sorts in the late £50's. Some plainer types early to mid £50's. A large entry of longer term and small stores that looked exceptionally dear with lambs up to £50 looking by far the dearest. Well bred sorts £44 to £52, with smaller and plainer types from £37 to £44. Very little less than £35. A good number of ram lambs - these to £78. Other strong sorts from £66 to £74. Farming types £57 to £64 and with six men to bid for them, smaller plainer sorts from £48 to £55.
