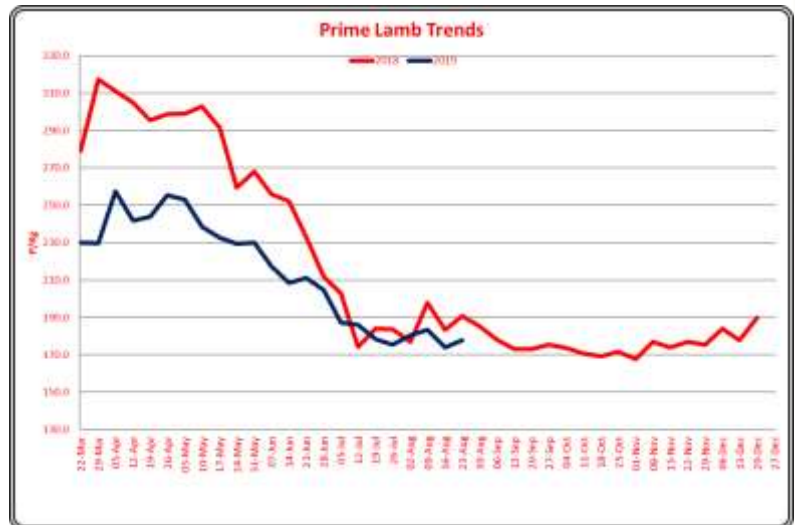
A very nice show of lambs sold to a stronger trade especially on the heavies. An overall average of 180p/kg achieved however the 45-52kg averaged 183p/kg. Plenty of demand on this weight bracket and outselling the standards. Plenty of pens 190p/kg plus topping at 212p/kg for a pen of 40kg from T W Stephens, Leylands, in fact the top 20 prices were all over 188p/kg, even a pen of 50.5kg selling to 192p/kg (£97/head)

Top price of the day went to a pen of 58kg from E J & J M Westoby that flew to £105.50/head. Any amount of heavies £90/head plus - in fact the top 20 pens were all in excess of £92.50/head. Meat and weight key and all in all a pleasing morning.

A similar entry with customers looking for the better sorts. Texel yearlings topped the day at 460gns with M/s G B & G G Morris selling four, others from 300gns to 450gns. Charollais yearlings ranged from 220gns to 350gns. Stronger Texel cross 3 year olds sold at 240gns and 250gns, others 100gns to 210gns. Just one smaller Suffolk yearling which sold at 170gns. Hardest to find a customer for were the lower priced poorer sorts.

More quality rams needed every week

REARING/WEANED CALVES - 27

The stronger the calf the stronger the money. 21 rearing calves sold to £275 for a Montbeliarde cross bull, the first of a draft of 15 with other stronger sorts from £150 to £235. Plainer sorts from £50 to £130. A stronger British Blue cross bull calf sold to £270 with smaller sorts from £45 to £160.

British Blue cross heifers continue to sell to good interest topping at £250, with a younger heifer at £210. The draft of 6 weaned calves were all Hereford cross from 12/16 weeks and sold in bunches from £305 to £340. Total clearance effected - these numbers can be sold every week.

Texel yearlings selling to a top of £155 with the top ten pens all from £140 to £155. Several yearlings then from £110 to £130 with only the smallest below £100.

Cheviot x Texel 2's to £140. Welsh Mule yearlings to £129, others at £120 and £110. Dorset yearlings to £95. Welsh Mule 3's to £93. Suffolk full mouth to £101, and again at £100 and £99. A selection of ewes of various breeds and ages from £70 to £90. Welsh 4's to £47.

Another excellent entry of lambs with more longer term types forward. The stronger lambs however would have more condition and these again easy to place. A super pen of Texel x lambs to £80. A bunch of 50 Suffolk x Mules to £72.80. All strength £66 to £75.80. Several lambs trading late £60's into the early £70's. Farming lambs similar - £60 to £65.50 with well bred sorts mid £60's and plainer sorts early £60's. A large show of medium keeping lambs and longer term sorts. The mid keeping lambs look easier on the week with fewer farmers forward due to combining and straw taking priority. The well bred sorts from £54 to £58, however some lambs looking well bought in the mid £50's. Harder bred and plainer sorts from £50 to £54 depending on strength.

A large show of longer term lambs - these again look the dearest sold with anything bred right from £47 to £52. Harder bred and smaller types £40 to £46.50. Very small from £32 to £40 and some of the dearest sold.

Ram lambs to £75.80, all strength £63 to £71. Farming types a little easier - these £54 to £60. Plainer and smaller sorts from £45 to £54.

A very buoyant trade from start to finish, in fact it is considered that they were dearer than prior to the festival with all weights in strong demand, especially the strongest ewes. The best Texels to £129/head but a definite shortage of those very best ewes. Plenty of those stronger Texels and Suffolks £100/head plus with the top 20 prices all over £97/head. Plenty of the Welsh and Speckle ewes £50 to £70 depending how they were made. Best rams to £115/head.

Today also saw a few grazing men about which was also putting a good bottom in the trade. Ten separate ewe buyers forward ensuring strong competition throughout.
