A short but quality entry of yearling ewes met with an excellent crowd of both local and distant purchasers, a strong Welsh contingent led to an excellent trade and superb clearance throughout. The vendors again did themselves proud with a tremendous show of ewes.

Top price for our champion pen of Texel x Mules from M/s J T Hartland at £170. A super pen of Texel x Mules from Mr J Morgan to £162. Other best Texel x Mule ewes £140 to £156. Plenty of Texel x Mules trading from £132 to £140, with smaller sorts from £120 to £130.

Suffolk x Mules less in number - these topped at £150 from M/s D & I M Jones. All the best Suffolk x Mules trading from £135 to £148, although £140 was on occasions a barrier. Well bred Suffolk x Mules £130 to £135. Smaller sorts from £120 to £130, very little below £120. Very few Mules - these topped £140 for North Country Mules. Welsh Mules to £140, other Mules £125 to £135 and look well bought. A larger entry needed for our second sale in September. Nearly a complete clearance with only two pens unsold.
