STORE CATTLE - 346

A smaller entry of stores, which included several good runs of stores from several vendors met another strong trade throughout. A good crowd of purchasers with several travelling buyers. Steers topped at £1310 for a super Limousin x steer from M/s R & S M Watson, this being sold late in the day highlighting that the trade was maintained throughout. Strong steers all £1120 to £1280 (190p-205p/kg), although short of strength today with a large show of farming and younger sorts.

A super consignment from M/s R S Preece & Son topped at £1130 on three occasions for Charolais x and Blue steers. Heifers topped at £1080 for a super bunch of Charolais x heifers, with the consignment averaging £1050 for steers and heifers. Farming steers all trading £950 to £1100 (215p-240p/kg) with the smart sorts all 225p-240p/kg, generally £1000 plus. Native Hereford steers from £850 to £950. Plainer sorts from £750 to £850 (175p-185p/kg). Younger steers meeting an excellent trade with several more farmers looking for grazing sorts. The smart sorts from £900 to £1000 (225p-246p/kg) with no end £850 to £900. Plainer types from £700 to £800. Very young sorts £650 to £750 with all types keenly sought after.

Heifers topped at £1155 for a super Limousin x from M/s Eynon. Others to £1110 from M/s R & S M Watson. Strong sorts all £1000 to £1100 (190p-215p/kg). Feeding heifers from £900 to £1040, smart butcher sorts all £950 to £1050 (215p-230p/kg), although less butcher sorts forward.

Plainer heifers from £800 to £900 (180p-195p/kg). Native types to £850, with generally smaller and younger heifers forward - these £700 to £800 (200-215p/kg) for some nice suckler bred Angus. Younger grazing heifers short in number with more fleshing sorts forward. Fleshing types a shade less - these £700 to £800 (180p-190p/kg). Store types a nice trade with the better sorts £700 to £850 (220p-237p/kg). More cattle will be needed for our next sale on 19th March with some good entries already to hand.

Eleven bull buyers in attendance ensuring a very competitive trade throughout, resulting in an average of £875/head and 218p/kg up to £1120 for an Angus from M/s D L & L J Jones. Any amount of those stronger types £1000/head plus and the smaller they were the dearer they were topping at 250p for a 240kg Blue bull from M/s Thomas, Duffryn Farm. A quality entry and a quality trade, a pleasure to sell!! Another good entry required for next sale.

COWS & CALVES - 10

A varied sample of cows and calves forward but all those that were forward were seriously well sold. An entry of older 10/13 year old Limousin cows and calves from The Weythel were well sold selling from £1260 to £1300. A run of Hereford x outfits that wanted farming also well sold to £1070.

A serious shortage of those continental suckler bred outfits that could be very well sold and are urgently required over the next few sales.

BARREN COWS - 24

After last sale's trade we ought to have had 100 barrens forward, which just shows the cows aren't out there. Today's trade was no different - in fact they could have been dearer especially considering the quality of cows forward. Strongest types to £1285/head for an 800kg Angus cow and 178p/kg for a 600kg Blue cow from M/s Clifton & Son. The cows averaged £800/head and 134p/kg. All those better meated cows were 140p/kg plus, especially the farm assured types. More cows are urgently required as the cows look like they are going to get dearer.
